### NOTES FROM THE WINEMAKER

As a young winery, we have yet to establish a deep selection of older vintages but the 2011 Petite Sirah is one of those rare treats. We held back a small, Club only stash of this wine because while it showed quite well as a young wine, we were sure the best was yet to come. Indeed, after almost 5 years of bottle maturity it's showing an elegance rare for this robust varietal. Flavors of coffee, strawberry and blueberry show a lovely version of Petite's gentler side. Pair with French Onion soup, rack of lamb, prime rib with a bleu cheese sauce, or dark chocolate.
