
SCHIOPPETTINO ESTATE GROWN SIERRA FOOTHILLS

The roads of Amador County in the Sierra Foothills wind through cattle ranches, oak woodlands, and vineyards boasting some of California's oldest vines. Completed in 2010, Andis' modern, state-of-the-art facility brought new energy to this once-overlooked region. In late 2016, the winery entered a bold new era: Napa-based winemaking consultant Philippe Melka, Maayan Koschitzky took on Andis Wines as their first-ever Sierra Foothills client. They were enticed to the region by Andy and Janis's single-minded dedication to quality and by the fascinating soils and ancient vines they found here.

Winemaker Notes

Andis Schioppettino has a medium intense purple color. The nose shows aromas of fresh black cherry blueberry pie and violets. This medium body red wine is dry with medium tannin. An easy-drinking wine with flavors of red and black fruit, pleasing notes of green olive pate. It pairs well with Eggplant parmesan or grilled rosemary Pork Chops with a side of green beans and tomatoes.
