
OLD MASSONI RANCH ZINFANDEL SIERRA FOOTHILLS



Vineyard Notes

Initially planted circa 1910, with some replantation post-prohibition, Old Massoni Ranch is one of California's historic vineyards, grown in well-drained, rich in iron, and decomposed granitic soils. Andis is honored to make a single vineyard wine enhancing the true characteristics of an old vine Zinfandel grown in well-drained, rich in iron, decomposed granite soils.

Winemaker Notes

Pale Ruby color and fragrance. With dark cherries and dried herbs flavors, this wine has a dusty and soft tannin typical of our region. The wine has a lively mouthfeel, complemented by a velvety, lingering finish.
