WINEMAKER NOTES

Since great Grenache is so sparsely planted in the Foothills, we source our fruit from several small vineyards throughout Amador County.

Aromas of fresh strawberries, cranberries, and roses fill the senses from this very pretty wine. Flavors of chocolate covered cherries, blackberries and tea are followed by hints of cinnamon and dusty oak. The wine finishes dry and fruitful. Tea smoked duck or a spiced walnut and cranberry salad are just a couple of ideas that would pair beautifully with this versatile wine.

"Bright medium ruby garnet color. Bright, fruity, jammy toasty aromas and flavors of strawberry jam, burning - dried leaves (leaf smoke), planked cedar, and pink sweet tarts with a chewy, tart, dryish full body and a warming, delightful, rapid finish with leafy, earthy tannins and light oak."
