Sweet fruits of strawberries, blackberries, and boysenberries are followed up with hints of chocolate, cherries, and tea flavors.

The wine finishes with a nice spice, earthy tones, and creamy oak.

Making it perfect for dishes like balsamic-braised rabbit with morels, or mushroom-stuffed veal breast.
