### WINEMAKER NOTES

Where a grapes wants to go a winemaker is wise to follow. Early on, this vintage of Cabernet Franc clearly called to be more Bordeaux than Loire. The 2014 we added 20% Merlot to encourage the already amazing structure and make a classic claret bottling. The wine has a dense character of chocolate truffles, cranberry juice and a touch of cafe au lait.
