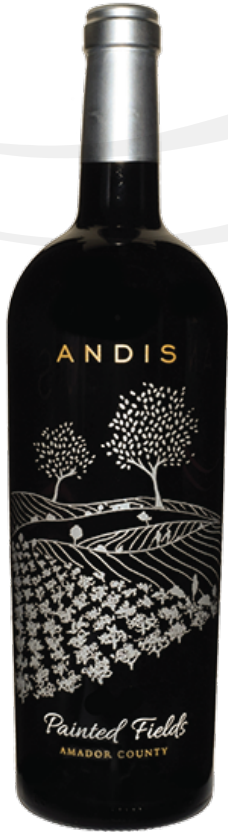

## 2014 PAINTED FIELDS RED BLEND

### WINEMAKER NOTES

Popular Hawaiian artist Kelly Sueda created this original label of the vineyards surrounding the winery. His personal interpretations of Hawaii's many natural wonders have made his work a favorite among art lovers and collectors. Here, Kelly blends observation of Amador's agriculture with imagination, the same partnership that makes great wine possible.

The 2013 Painted Fields is ruby black in color. It has fruity, creamy aromas with flavors of boysenberry custard, delicate spices, and chocolate toffee with a satiny, vibrant, dry-yet-fruity medium-to-full body and a tingling, engaging, medium-length Neapolitan gelato, craisin, sweet and peppery spice, and cedar finish with well-integrated, chewy tannins and moderate oak. A supple, chewy red blend with structure that will shine at the table.
