Our Amador Zinfandel is sourced from the diverse blocks of our Estate Vineyard located in the Shenandoah Valley of Amador County. We bring together two of Amador's traditional grape varieties to compose a wine very similar to what was likely being produced here in the late 1800's. Dried berries boysenberry, and blackberry fruit flavors are allowed nicely with hints of coffee, toffee, and licorice.
