His personal interpretations of Hawaii's many natural wonders have made his work a favorite among art lovers and collectors. This is a smooth-textured and well-balanced wine. It smells a little smoky, but tastes moderately crisp and tannic, with ripe fruit favors to balance out the tartness.
