### WINEMAKER NOTES

One of my favorite times of the year is just after harvest when the white wines are done fermenting and still in the tanks. They're chilled to the low 40's to keep them fresh and stable, filling the cellar with beautiful aromas.

Pale white gold color. Delicate, tropical, citrusy aromas and flavors of grapefruit custard, guava, and plantain with a supple, bright, fruity light-to-medium body and a smooth, relaxed lemon curd and wheatgrass finish with no oak. A solid, refreshing sipper.

Serve this enticing wine chilled alongside seafood, light pasta dishes, and chicken.
