WINEMAKER NOTES

One of my favorite times of the year is just after harvest when the white wines are done fermenting and still in the tanks. They're chilled to the low 40's to keep them fresh and stable, filling the cellar with beautiful aromas.

39 years ago, a visionary grape grower named Bill Dillian planted these beautiful, head trained Semillon vines in the heart of Amador County. Since 2010 it has been our pleasure to craft wine from these meticulously cared for vines. Aromas of green apple, fig and honeysuckle make for a wildly wonderful pairing for shellfish, sushi, and hard cheese.
