The 2017 Cuvée Blanc is a medium-bodied white blend inspired by the traditional Bordeaux-style wines of France. Light and fruity with aromas of citrus and passionfruit, the palate blends together notes of orange zest and honeysuckle that lead to a long, lingering finish.
