


2017 ESTATE ROSE

Delicate and refreshing while showing surprising complexity, the rosé is in many ways the prettiest wine we make each year. A symphony of watermelon and pink grapefruit usher in flavors of fresh cut stone fruit. Perfect as an aperitif, on the porch or by the pool.
