
SAUVIGNON BLANC CODEVILLA VINEYARD



Vineyard Notes

Planting white wine grapes in the Sierra Foothills was not very common in the early days, but forward-thinking growers took a chance in the mid 1970s planting a few acres. Today this high elevation vineyard is one of the most unique and oldest Sauvignon Blanc vineyards in the California Shenandoah Valley AVA. The quality of the vineyard inspired our winemaking team, to produce a full bodied white wine fermented and aged in French Oak and steel Drums.

Winemaker Notes

2018 Sauvignon Blanc has an explosion of fruits on the nose. Flavors of of freshly baked brioche and oak vanilla make this wine an elegant and full body white wine. The lemon zest finish adds another layer to put the wine in a perfect harmony.
